Sunshine and flipflops,


Ice creams and lollipops,

This activity-based assignment will foster curiosity, develop creativity, enhance knowledge, and instill the joy of learning among you all. It will certainly help you to discover a new you, who is more enriched and confident and performs every action to perfection.

You may help your child to:

- Appreciate nature
- Take a walk and hunt for colours.
- Look at family photo together.
- Converse in English.
- Narrate stories with moral.
- Avoid video games; instead play interesting games like chess, ludo, etc.

So, embark on a journey of fun and adventure by meditating, dancing, and channelizing your energy in a positive manner.

Personal hygiene:

Healthy mind resides in a healthy body. Start your day early and set a daily routine. Encourage your child to take care of personal hygiene. They must.....

- Wash hands frequently
- Trim their nails.
- Take bath every day.
- Brush their teeth twice a day.
- Cover nose and mouth when he/she sneezes.
- Stay positive, work hard, exercise regularly, and eat healthy food to keep yourself fit and healthy.

Encourage practical life activities-

Encourage kids to be independent from a very early age. Teaching basic life skills will help them to manage their simple, daily activities by themselves.



Dressing and undressing, Tying shoelaces, buttoning a shirt, pouring water from jug into a cup, learn to garden, and clean up time are some of the activities which need to be practised with child. You may have a box/basket of empty jars/ containers and lids and encourage your child to match the lid with the correct container. Capture all these precious moments and make a picture booklet/ photo album of your child, learning practical life skills.

Games



Play indoor games with your child like ludo and carom board. Play letter games, spin wheel games like jump up and down, and stand on one leg to involve them in physical activities.

Language Enhancement

***Story time**

Read books to your child. Look at story books together. Invite your child to talk about the story. Ask few questions related to the story such as “What did you like about the story? Who was your favourite character? How would you have reacted in this situation? What do you think to happen next? Does the story remind you of something you have experienced, or of any other story you know?” Reading to your child helps develop linguistic skills. You may help your child to make any one puppet of his/her choice using sticks, socks etc. Learn few lines about your favourite character in the story.

- Tales from Panchatantra

* Children feel so confident in introducing themselves to others. Help your child to learn at least five to six lines on any one of the following topics:

- 1) Myself
- 2) My family
- 3) My favourite colour

*Create a letter tree (Nursery)/ Word tree (KG) out of disposable container and craft paper to enhance the reading skills of the child.

Special Activities

1) Helping Bag

Help your child to make an attractive handmade bag with an old newspaper or magazine. Decorate it and write the name, class, and section of your child. Ask kids to keep all the materials they want to share with others like pencil sharpeners, biscuits etc. After the holidays, distribute the things among needy children in the vicinity.



2) Puzzles give brain a fun works out.



Solving puzzles on a regular basis help in development of cognitive skills. Spot the difference, connect the dots, mazes, crosswords are some of the puzzles which can be found online and in newspapers. Please pick up age appropriate puzzles as per your child's level of understanding. Help them to solve these puzzles.

3) Best out of Waste

You engage yourself to create something best out of waste material. You can make things like pencil stand, wall hangings, photo frame, etc. or any other thing of your choice from the waste material available in your home.
