- 1. MAME: The name of the Society shall be "DARSHAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION."
- 2. MEMBERSHIP:

(1) ELIGIBILITY:

The following conditions shall govern the eligibility for the Membership of the Society:-

- (a) He/She should be an initiate of Hazur Baba Sawan Singh Ji Maharaj or His Holiness Param Sant Kirpal Singh Ji Maharaj or H.H. Param Sant Darshan Singh Ji Maharaj or Sant Rajinder Singh Ji Maharaj or His Successor(s);
- (b) He/She should believe in the aims and objects of the society;
- (c) He/She should be a pure vegetarian and testotaller and must not be addicted to any form of intoxication;
- (d) He/She should be moral; ethical and simple like, be of sound personal princacter and shall be frankly years old;
- (e) He/She must not have been convicted of any offence involving moral turpidude noncember he be an insane or insolvent person;

(2) ENROLMENT:

- I. The enrollment of a member of the society shall be made by a simple majority of the total members of the Managing Committee of the society in its Meeting when his/her name is proposed and seconded by two members of the Managing Committee of the Society one of whom should be the Chairman of the Society;
- II. The Managing Committee has the exclusive right to admit or not to admit any person as a member of the society and the reasons of the rejection of the membership shall be communicated to the person concerned.

(3) REMOVAL OF MEMBERS:

- I. The Managing Committee of the Society may remove any member of the society on the following grounds:-

- (b) If a member fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the General Body/Managing Committee;
- (c) In the event of the member being convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude or becoming insane or insolvent;
- (d) In the event of the member failing to or ceasing to comply with the eligibility conditions land in Rule 2(1) hereinabove.
- II. Any member upon his/her death or upon submitting a Resignation from the membership of the Managing Committee/General Body in writing addresses to Chairman, shall cease to be a member of the offict from the date of the date of the committee of acceptance of his/her Resignation by the Chairman on the recommendations of the Managing Committee of the Society, as the case may be. The reasons for removal from membership shall be communicated to the person concerned.

3. GENERAL BODY.





MANAGEMENT:

- (1) The management of the affairs of the Society shall vest in the Managing Committee of the Society. entire property and total assets of the society shall also vest in the Managing Committee along with the executive authority. The Managing Committee with the consent of the Chairman may delegate authority and powers to any person for the proper and smooth working of the society, and may withdraw such authority or powers without assigning any reason.
- (2) The Managing Committee with more than two third majority and with the consent of the Chairman may dispose of any property in the interest of the Society or may incur debt or liability on behalf of the Society

MISCELLANEOUS RULES:

- The accounting year (financial year) of the (1)society shall be from the first day of April of each English Calender Month to the thirty first day of March of each succeeding year.
- (2) Donations, fees, grants-in-aid, and gifts from members and the general public shall be amongst the sources of income of the Society. All the income of the Society shall be utilized for the achievement of aims and objects of the Society.
- The funds of the society shall be kept in a Scheduled Bank. The Bank Account shall be operated under the signature of the followings:-
 - Chairman or His Nominee with any one of the following:-
 - (B) General Secretary; or
 - (C) Treasurer.

The Chairman may delegate such powers to any Member of the Society.

- Once in every (4) fourteenth day succeeding the day on which the Annual General Meeting of the Society is held, List of Names, year, Addresses, Occupations, and designations of the Members of the Managing Committee shall be sent to the Registrar of Societies;
- Whenever it shall appear to the Managing Committee of the Society, that it is advisable to alter, extend or abridge any particular purpose within the meaning of the Societies Registration Act, or to amalgamate the Society either wholly or partially with any other Society or Societies, the Managing Committee may submit the proposal to the members of the Society a written or printed report and may convene special meeting for the consideration thereof according to the Regulations of the Society, but no such proposal shall Regulations of the Society, but no such proposal shall be carried into effect unless such report shall have been delivered or sent by post to every member of the society ten days previous to Special Meeting convened by the Managing Committee for consideration thereof, nor unless such proposal the base been agreed to by the votes of more than three fourth the confirmed by the wortes of more than three fourth to the hembers present at a second special Meeting convened by the Managing Committee at an interval of checkenth after the formal meeting.
- (6) All the disputes or differences relating to the affairs and conduct of the business of the Society shall be referred to the Chairman whose decision shall be final and binding upon all parties and shall not be questioned in any menner in any forum in any circumstances except with his permission.
- Members, not less than three-fourth Managing Committee, may determine that it shall be dissolved forthwith, or at the time then agreed upon, and all necessary steps shall be taken for the disposal and settlement of the property or the society, its claims and liabilities according to the Rules of the Society applicable thereto, if any, and if not then as the Managing Committee shall find expedient, provided

that, in the event of any dispute arising among the said Managing Committee or the members of the Society, the adjustment of its affairs shall be referred to the principal Court of Original Civil Jurisdiction of the Delhi in which the chief building of the society is situated, and the court shall make such orders regarding matter as it shall deem requisite, provided that the Society shall not be dissolved unless three-fourth of the members shall have expressed a wish for such dissolution by their votes delivered in person or by proxy at a general meeting convened for the purpose.

- (8) If upon the dissolution of the society there shall remain after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid, distributed amongst the members of the society or any of them, but shall be given to some other society to be determined by the votes of not less than three-fourth of the members present personally at the time of the dissolution in default thereof, by such court as aforesaid in Clauser (2)
- (9) The Society small maintain its Books of Accounts at its registered office and its Branches all over India and shall get its Accounts audited each year from a reputed Chantered Accountant according to law.
- (10) The Chairman of the Society shall be competent to fill up the casual vacancies on the cessation of membership of any member of the Society and such filling up of vacancies may be notified by the Society to the Registrar of Societies at Delhi according to law.

The Chairman may at his sole discretion, allow any member of the Society to be re-admitted to the Society on cassation of his/her membership provided he/she qualifies for its Membership as per above Rules and Regulations.

(11) The Society may sue or be sued in its own name through its General Secretary or any other person as determined by the Managing Committee of the Society as per provisions laid down under Section 6 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as made applicable to the Union Territory of Delhi.






