These engaging activities aimed to instill a sense of responsibility in young learners, encouraging them to contribute positively to society and the environment.





Students participated with great enthusiasm and came up with creative slogans and beautiful drawings to support the cause.


Students of Grades I and II also planted saplings in the school campus, adding meaning to the celebration through hands-on contribution to nature.
